College Park was incorporated in 1891. The affairs of the City are conducted by a Mayor and Council consisting of five members. All corporate powers are vested in the Mayor and the Council. The Mayor and members of the Council serve four-year terms of office. The City is divided into four wards, and the members of the Council are elected only by the voters of the ward from which he or she offers for election.

Council meetings are held the first and third Monday of each month. The Mayor presides at all meetings of the Mayor and Council and has a vote only in the case of a tie vote by the members of the Council.

The City Manager, who is appointed by and serves at the pleasure of the Mayor and Council, is the head of the administrative branch of the municipal government of the City and is responsible for the efficient and effective administration of College Park.
