3 **ORDINANCE NO. 2017-15**

4 AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 19-25 (“SAME—DESIGNATED”) AND
5 SECTION 19-25.1 (COMMERCIAL MOTOR VEHICLES REGULATED ON PORTIONS OF
6 HERSCHEL ROAD AND RIVERDALE ROAD), IN ARTICLE II (“OPERATION OF
7 VEHICLES”), CHAPTER 19 (“TRAFFIC”) OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, CITY OF
8 COLLEGE PARK, GEORGIA; TO PROVIDE FOR SEVERABILITY; TO PROVIDE FOR
9 REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; TO PROVIDE AN ADOPTION AND
10 EFFECTIVE DATE; AND TO PROVIDE FOR OTHER LAWFUL PURPOSES.

11 **WHEREAS**, the duly elected governing authority of the City of College Park, Georgia is
12 the Mayor and Council thereof; and

13 **WHEREAS**, the governing authority desires to amend said sections to update the
14 designated truck routes in the City and regulate commercial motor vehicles from operating
15 certain portions of Herschel and Riverdale Roads; and

16 **WHEREAS**, the amendments contained herein would benefit the health, safety, morals,
17 and welfare of the citizens of the City.

18 **BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED** by the Mayor and Council of the City of
19 College Park, Georgia, and by the authority thereof:

20 **Section One.** Section 19-25 (“Same—Designated”) in Article II (“Operation of
21 Vehicles), Chapter 19 (“Traffic”) of the Code of Ordinances, City of College Park, Georgia, is
22 hereby amended by striking in its entirety, the provisions presently found in said Section and
23 inserting in lieu thereof new text, which shall read and be codified as follows:

24 **“Sec. 19-25. - Designated Truck Routes.**

25 The following streets in and through the city are designated as truck routes:

- 26 (1) *Interstate 85*: Beginning at the east city limits on Interstate 85 and continuing in a
27 southwesterly direction to the west city limits.
- 28 (2) *Interstate 285*: Beginning at its intersection with the east city limits at State Route 139
29 (Riverdale Road) and continuing in a westerly direction to the west city limits on
30 interstate 285.
- 31 (3) *U.S. Highway 29*: Beginning at the north city limits on U.S. Highway 29 and continuing
32 on said highway to the southernmost city limits on U.S. Highway 29.
- 33 (4) *State Route 139 (Riverdale Road)*: Beginning at the intersection of the eastern city
34 limits and Riverdale Road and continuing north on Riverdale Road to its intersection
35 with the Global Gateway Connector.
- 36 (5) *State Route 279*: Beginning at its intersection with U.S. Highway 29 and continuing
37 south to Old Bill Cook Road.
- 38 (6) *State Route 314 (West Fayetteville Road)*: Beginning at the intersection of Riverdale
39 Road and West Fayetteville Road and continuing on West Fayetteville Road to the
40 south city limits at Phoenix Parkway.
- 41 (7) *Camp Creek Parkway*: Beginning at the west city limits on Camp Creek Parkway and
42 continuing on said street to its intersection with Interstate 85.
- 43 (8) *Edison Drive*: Beginning at the intersection of West Point and Edison Drive and
44 continuing south on Edison Drive to Sullivan Road.
- 45 (9) *Embassy Drive*: Beginning at the intersection of Edison Drive and Embassy Drive and
46 continuing on Embassy Drive to Riverdale Road.
- 47 (10) *Howell Slade Circle*: Beginning at the intersection of Virginia Avenue and Howell
48 Slade Circle and continuing in a northeast direction to the intersection of Howell Slade
49 Circle and Main Street.
- 50 (11) *Massachusetts Boulevard*: Beginning at the intersection of Sullivan Road and
51 continuing on Massachusetts Boulevard to its terminus.
- 52 (12) *Sullivan Road*: Beginning at the east city limits on Sullivan Road and continuing west
53 on Sullivan Road to west city limits at Rock Hill Road.
- 54 (13) *Virginia Avenue*: Beginning at the intersection of the east city limits and continuing on
55 Virginia Avenue in a westerly direction to the intersection of Howell Slade Circle and
56 Virginia Avenue.
- 57 (14) *West Point Avenue*: Beginning at Sullivan Road and continuing in a northeasterly
58 direction to the intersection of Lesley Drive and West Point Avenue.
- 59 (15) *Wickersham Drive*: Beginning at the intersection of West Point Avenue and
60 Wickersham Drive and continuing on Wickersham Drive to dead end.
- 61 (16) *Best Road*: Beginning at the intersection of Sullivan Road and Best Road and
62 continuing north on Best Road to West Point Avenue.

- 63 (17) *Godby Road*: Beginning at the intersection of Godby Road and Charbett Drive and
64 continuing east on Godby Road to West Fayetteville Road.
- 65 (18) *Southampton Road*: Beginning at the south city limits on Southampton Road and
66 continuing east on Southampton Road to West Fayetteville Road.
- 67 (19) *Global Gateway Connector*: Beginning at the intersection of Global Gateway
68 Connector and State Route 139 (Riverdale Road) and continuing north on Global
69 Gateway Connector to its intersection with Camp Creek Parkway.
- 70 (20) *Lesley Drive*: Beginning at the intersection of Lesley Drive and West Point Avenue and
71 continuing on Lesley Drive to its intersection with U.S. Highway 29.
- 72 (21) *Georgia State Route Spur 14*: Beginning at its junction with Interstate 285 continuing
73 to the western city limits on Spur 14 to U.S. Highway 29.
- 74 (22) *Buffington Road*: Beginning at the intersection of Buffington Road and U.S. Highway
75 29 and continuing south on Buffington Road to the south city limits.
- 76 (23) *Naturally Fresh Boulevard*: Beginning at the intersection of Naturally Fresh Boulevard
77 and Buffington Road and continuing on Naturally Fresh Boulevard to its terminus.
- 78 (24) *Riverdale Road Connector*: Beginning at its intersection with U.S. Highway 29 and
79 continuing north on Riverdale Road Connector to Global Gateway Connector.
- 80 (25) *T. Owen Smith Connector*: Beginning at its intersection with Riverdale Road and
81 continuing on T. Owen Smith Connector to Best Road.
- 82 (26) *Herschel Road*: Beginning at the intersection of Herschel Road at its intersection with
83 U.S. Highway 29 and continuing north on Herschel Road to its intersection with Old
84 National Highway.”

86 **Section Two.** Section 19-25.1 (“Commercial motor vehicles regulated on portions of
87 Herschel Road and Riverdale Road”) in Article II (“Operation of Vehicles), Chapter 19
88 (“Traffic”) of the Code of Ordinances, City of College Park, Georgia, is hereby amended by
89 striking the provisions presently found in subsection (a) and inserting in lieu thereof new text
90 which shall read and be codified as follows:

91 “(a) It shall be unlawful, except as otherwise provided in Section 19-25, for any person to
92 operate any commercial motor vehicle on the following portions of Herschel Road and
93 Riverdale Road:

- 94 (1) *Herschel Road*: Beginning at the north city limits on Herschel Road and continuing
95 south on Herschel Road to its intersection with Old National Highway.
- 96 (2) *Riverdale Road*: Beginning at Riverdale Road’s intersection with Global Gateway
97 Connector/Riverdale Road Connector and continuing west on Riverdale Road to its
98 intersection with Herschel Road.”

100 **Section Three.** The preamble of this Ordinance shall be considered to be and is hereby
101 incorporated by reference as if fully set out herein.

102 **Section Four.** This Ordinance shall be codified in a manner consistent with the laws of
103 the State of Georgia and the City.

104 **Section Five.** (a) It is hereby declared to be the intention of the Mayor and Council that
105 all sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses and phrases of this Ordinance are or were, upon their
106 enactment, believed by the Mayor and Council to be fully valid, enforceable and constitutional.

107 (b) It is hereby declared to be the intention of the Mayor and Council that, to the greatest
108 extent allowed by law, each and every section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this
109 Ordinance is severable from every other section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this
110 Ordinance. It is hereby further declared to be the intention of the Mayor and Council that, to the
111 greatest extent allowed by law, no section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this
112 Ordinance is mutually dependent upon any other section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase
113 of this Ordinance.

114 (c) In the event that any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section of this Ordinance
115 shall, for any reason whatsoever, be declared invalid, unconstitutional or otherwise
116 unenforceable by the valid judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, it is the
117 express intent of the Mayor and Council that such invalidity, unconstitutionality or
118 unenforceability shall, to the greatest extent allowed by law, not render invalid, unconstitutional
119 or otherwise unenforceable any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs or
120 sections of the Ordinance and that, to the greatest extent allowed by law, all remaining phrases,
121 clauses, sentences, paragraphs and sections of the Ordinance shall remain valid, constitutional,
122 enforceable, and of full force and effect.

123 **Section Six.** All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby
124 expressly repealed.

125 **Section Seven.** Unless otherwise provided for herein, penalties in effect for violations of
126 the Code of Ordinances of the City of College Park, Georgia at the time of the effective date of
127 this Ordinance shall be and are hereby made applicable to this Ordinance and shall remain in full
128 force and effect.

129 **Section Eight.** The effective date of this Ordinance shall be the date of adoption unless
130 otherwise stated herein.
