3 **ORDINANCE NO. 2015-21**

4 AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE WARD LINES OF THE CITY OF
5 COLLEGE PARK, GEORGIA, AS AMENDED, TO PROVIDE FOR THE
6 REDRAWING OF THE WARD LINES; TO PROVIDE FOR ADOPTION OF A
7 NEW MAP SHOWING THE NEW WARD LINES; TO PROVIDE FOR
8 SEVERABILITY; TO REPEAL CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; TO
9 PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

11 **WHEREAS**, O.C.G.A. § 21-2-261(a) authorizes the City of College Park, Georgia (the
12 “City”) to alter the boundaries of its wards; and

13 **WHEREAS**, the City desires to amend its ward lines to better suit the convenience of the
14 electors and to promote the public interests; and

15 **WHEREAS**, this amendment will remove certain portions of land known as the Charles
16 Phillips Park from Ward 2, and will place said portions of land within the boundaries of Ward 4:

17 and

18 **WHEREAS**, this amendment will incorporate the newly annexed areas of land into the
19 new ward map of the City; and

20 **WHEREAS**, the amendments contained herein would benefit the health, safety, morals
21 and welfare of the citizens of the City.

22 BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE
23 CITY OF COLLEGE PARK, GEORGIA, and by the authority thereof:

24 Section 1. The ward lines of the City of College Park, Georgia are hereby amended as
25 shown in the ward map attached hereto as Exhibit "A." This new Exhibit "A" shall be the official
26 ward map of the City, and shall replace the original Exhibit "A" which is maintained in the office
27 of the City Clerk.

28 Section 2. The preamble of this Ordinance shall be considered to be and is hereby
29 incorporated by reference as if fully set out herein.

30 Section 3. This Ordinance shall be codified in a manner consistent with the laws of the
31 State of Georgia and the City of College Park.

32 Section 4. (a) It is hereby declared to be the intention of the Mayor and Council that all
33 sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses and phrases of this Ordinance are or were, upon their
34 enactment, believed by the Mayor and Council to be fully valid, enforceable and constitutional.

35 (b) It is hereby declared to be the intention of the Mayor and Council that, to the greatest
36 extent allowed by law, each and every section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this
37 Ordinance is severable from every other section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this
38 Ordinance. It is hereby further declared to be the intention of the Mayor and Council that, to the
39 greatest extent allowed by law, no section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this
40 Ordinance is mutually dependent upon any other section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase
41 of this Ordinance.

42 (c) In the event that any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section of this Ordinance
43 shall, for any reason whatsoever, be declared invalid, unconstitutional or otherwise

44 unenforceable by the valid judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, it is the
45 express intent of the Mayor and Council that such invalidity, unconstitutionality or
46 unenforceability shall, to the greatest extent allowed by law, not render invalid, unconstitutional
47 or otherwise unenforceable any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs or
48 sections of the Ordinance and that, to the greatest extent allowed by law, all remaining phrases,
49 clauses, sentences, paragraphs and sections of the Ordinance shall remain valid, constitutional,
50 enforceable, and of full force and effect.

51 Section 5. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby
52 expressly repealed.

53 Section 6. Unless otherwise provided for herein, penalties in effect for violations of the
54 Code of Ordinances of the City of College Park at the time of the effective date of this Ordinance
55 shall be and are hereby made applicable to this Ordinance and shall remain in full force and
56 effect.


57 Section 7. The effective date of this Ordinance shall be the date of adoption unless
58 otherwise specified herein.

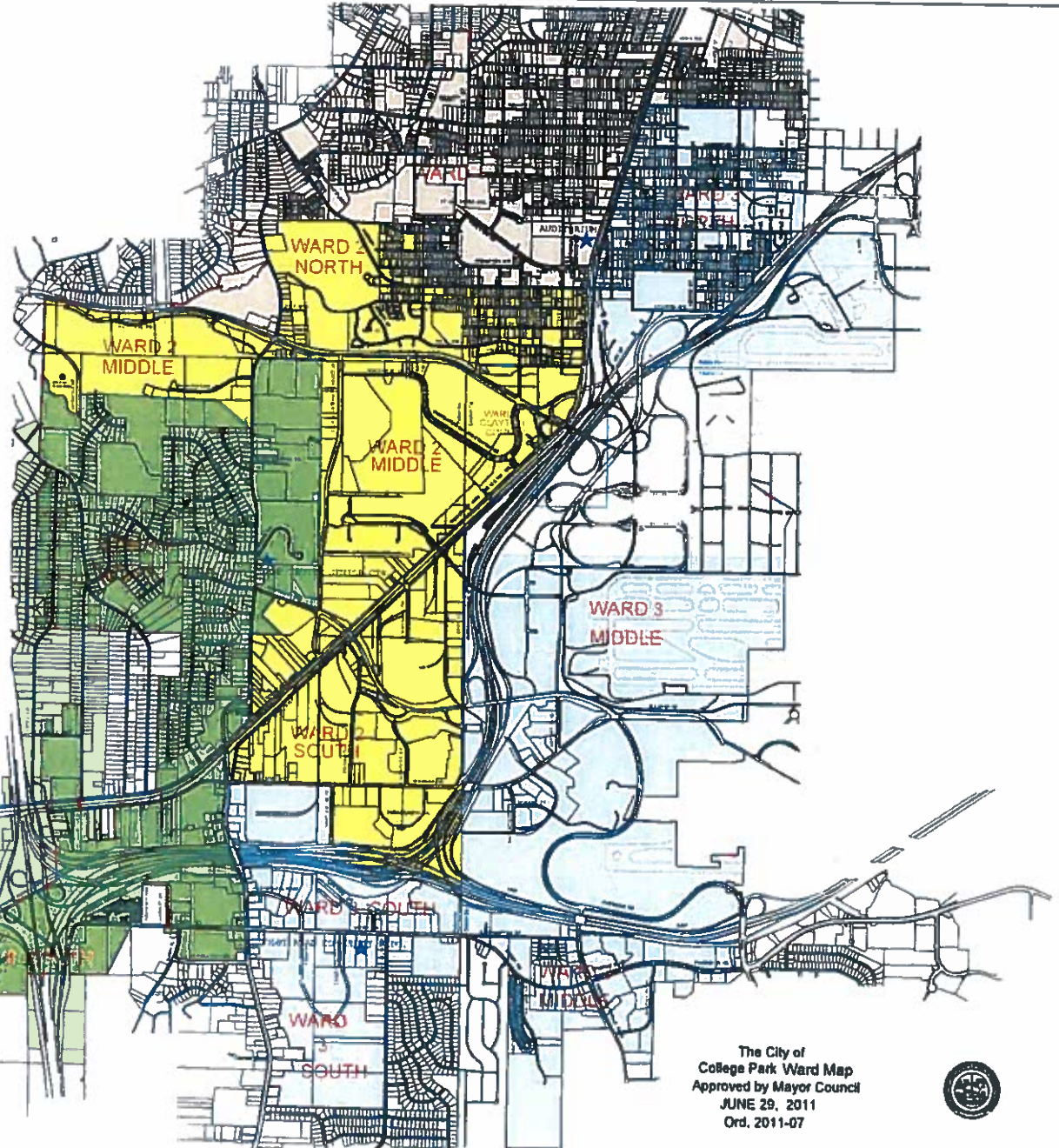
