5 ORDINANCE NO. 2016-05

7 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 19-47, LEFT TURNS TO STREET PARKING

8 PROHIBITED, OF ARTICLE II, OPERATION OF VEHICLES, OF CHAPTER 19, TRAFFIC;

9 TO PROVIDE FOR SEVERABILITY; TO REPEAL CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; TO

10 PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

11 WHEREAS, the duly elected governing authority of the City of College Park (“City”) is  
12 the Mayor and Council thereof; and

13 WHEREAS, the City finds it necessary to amend Section 19-47 of its Code to update  
14 street names referenced therein; and

15 WHEREAS, the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of College Park, Georgia, will  
16 be positively impacted by the adoption of this Ordinance.

17 BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF  
18 THE CITY OF COLLEGE PARK, GEORGIA, and by the authority thereof:

20 Section 1: The Code of Ordinances, City of College Park, Georgia, is hereby amended

21 by striking the existing text of Section 19-47, Left Turns to Street Parking Prohibited, of Article

22 II, Operation Of Vehicles, of Chapter 19, Traffic, and, in lieu thereof, inserting the following:

24 “Sec. 19-47. – Left turns to street parking prohibited.

25

26 No person shall cause or attempt to cause any vehicle to turn left into street  
27 parking on Main Street between Hawthorne Avenue and Yale Avenue, unless so  
28 directed by a law enforcement agent. “Street parking” is defined as the public  
29 parking adjoining the roadway.”

30                    Section 2. The preamble of this Ordinance shall be considered to be and is hereby  
31 incorporated by reference as if fully set out herein.

32

33                    Section 3. This Ordinance shall be codified in a manner consistent with the laws of the  
34 State of Georgia and the City.

35                    Section 4. (a) It is hereby declared to be the intention of the Mayor and Council that all  
36 sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses and phrases of this Ordinance are or were, upon their  
37 enactment, believed by the Mayor and Council to be fully valid, enforceable and constitutional.

38                    (b) It is hereby declared to be the intention of the Mayor and Council that, to the greatest  
39 extent allowed by law, each and every section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this  
40 Ordinance is severable from every other section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this  
41 Ordinance. It is hereby further declared to be the intention of the Mayor and Council that, to the  
42 greatest extent allowed by law, no section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this  
43 Ordinance is mutually dependent upon any other section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase  
44 of this Ordinance.

45                    (c) In the event that any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section of this Ordinance  
46 shall, for any reason whatsoever, be declared invalid, unconstitutional or otherwise  
47 unenforceable by the valid judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, it is the  
48 express intent of the Mayor and Council that such invalidity, unconstitutionality or  
49 unenforceability shall, to the greatest extent allowed by law, not render invalid, unconstitutional  
50 or otherwise unenforceable any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs or  
51 sections of the Ordinance and that, to the greatest extent allowed by law, all remaining phrases,  
52 clauses, sentences, paragraphs and sections of the Ordinance shall remain valid, constitutional,  
53 enforceable, and of full force and effect.

54 Section 5. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby  
55 expressly repealed.

56 Section 6. The effective date of this Ordinance shall be the date of adoption unless  
57 otherwise stated herein.
