We already have several Food Truck Owners interested in supporting this effort and are eager to begin construction.



Thank you for the opportunity to make this presentation to establish a Pedicabs Ambassador Program in College Park.

Prior accomplishments

Made presentation to College Park Main Street Association, Inc. on April 21, 2021. Answered questions and followed through on additional questions they had. Received a Letter of Support from CPMSA on May 20, 2021. The presentation name is: PEDICABS IN COLLEGE PARK (8 slides). You will find it in the Appendix.

Our collaboration partners: Main Street Pedicabs (Colorado) and Joyride Pedicabs (Atlanta).

Proposed Pedicab Street Plan – College Park

August 2, 2021

This document describes the proposed Pedicab Street Plan. It emphasizes the approximate Pickup and Dropoff locations, streets, and business names. We can provide further details as needed.

The key through streets to travel that we need access to are:

- Access: North and South Is East Main Street, College Street, Conley Street, West Point Avenue, Best Road, St. Lesley Drive, Convention Center Concourse, Gateway Center, and Gateway Boulevard.
- Access: Cross over street from Main Street to East Main at Harvard Avenue and Rugby.
 Take Hardin Avenue (East & West) to access all businesses on Virginia Avenue and Bobby Brown Parkway and Norman Berry Drive.
- Access: Harrison Street for Pickup and Dropoff on Virginia Avenue. For Pickup and Dropoff passenger at Hotels on Norman Berry Drive.
- The heart of Main Street College Street, Harvard Avenue, Columbia Avenue, John Wesley are Pickup and Dropoff locations at corners and in the middle of the block. These are cross streets that run into Main Street.
- John Wesley, Tom Dick and Harry Restaurant, Corner Grille, Johnny's Chicken and Waffles, Virgil's, Milk and Honey, and Hattie Marie's Texas Style BBQ & Cajun Chicken Kitchen. These are between Princeton Avenue and John Calvin on Main Street.
- Pickup and Dropoff locations for Johnny Crickets, Virginia Avenue, Wayfield Food, College Park Cemetery. Between Myrtle and Harrison Streets on Virginia Avenue, we have Drip Coffee, Blimpie Restaurant, Taco Kitchen, Mellow Mushroom Pizza, Chinese Food, Claire Hotel, Waffle House, Motel Six, Kentucky Fried Chicken, Holiday Inn.
- Harrison Road Pickup and Dropoff locations Arby's, Sonesta Hotel, Druid Hotel & Suite, Ruby Tuesday, Waffle House, McDonalds, and Hilton Hotel.

- We need down Harrison Road to Cambridge Ave. This gives us access to Hardin Avenue, up to Bobby Brown Parkway and Norman Berry Drive, The Crab Spot, Hilton, Delta Airline, 85 expressway turning on Norman Berry Drive and La Quinta Hotel, Kings Cigar, Boyd's Auto Repair, Hyatt Place, Strawbridge Hotel, Stay Bridge Hotel, Doubletree Hotel, Avis Car Rental on Bobby Brown Parkway, Fairfield Inn and Suites on Walker Avenue, Homewood Suites on Cambridge Avenue.
- Pickup and Dropoff locations Main St. to Rugby Avenue, Main Street at the Brake Pad, the Woman's Club.
- Hardin Avenue to access Virginia Avenue, Norman Berry Drive, and Bobby Brown Parkway.
